

Newsletter #5, 19 February 2021

- The 2nd TEAMx Workshop will be held as an online event from Monday 10th Wednesday 12th May, between 16:00-19:00 CEST. The workshop will focus on the plan for the TEAMx Observational Campaign (now scheduled to take place from Spring 2024-Spring 2025). A draft document outlining the plan for the campaign will be shared via the TEAMx Working Groups well in advance of the workshop. More details to follow - for now, please save the date!
- 2. As the planning for the experimental (modelling and observational) aspects of TEAMx will be co-ordinated through the Working Groups, if you are interested in contributing please make sure that you are part of one (or more!) of the six Working Groups detailed on the <u>website</u>.
- 3. On 18 January 2021 the World Weather Research Programme (WWRP) made TEAMx a WWRP endorsed project. With this, WMO recognizes the relevance of mountains and mountain ranges at the same time for climate (TEAMx being cross-cutting project within the Hydroclimate Panel of GEWEX, i.e. within WCRP) and weather (TEAMx being a WWRP endorsed project).
- 4. The TEAMx Memorandum of Understanding has recently been signed by the <u>Swiss Federal</u> <u>Institute for Forest, Snow and Landscape Research WSL</u> and <u>WSL Institute for Snow and</u> <u>Avalanche Research SLF, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, DWD</u>, the <u>University of</u> <u>Iceland</u> and the <u>University of East Anglia</u>. There are now <u>26</u> research institutions and weather services affiliated with TEAMx.
