- 1. The 2nd TEAMx Workshop took place online on Monday 10th Wednesday 12th May and focused on developing the plan for the TEAMx Observational Campaign (TOC). With more than 180 participants in total we had some very fruitful discussions about planned measurements and project ideas and a range of interesting presentations. Over the next few weeks, the Working Groups will prepare their comments on the draft plan and a revised version of the document will be shared later this summer.

As not everyone was able to attend the workshop (or all sessions of the workshop), we would like to make the recordings of the meeting and one-slide summaries available under a password protected area on the TEAMx website which TEAMx members (but not the general public) will be able to access.
